RULES

ALL DEFRA REGULATIONS TO BE FOLLOWED

1. All sheep and cattle entries must be in by August 29th 2019.
2. No stock to be removed before 5 pm.
3. All stock must be the property of the exhibitor for at least 3 months.
4. All dogs must be kept on a lead.
5. All cups to be returned to the Secretary 14 days before the Show.
6. If 2 exhibitors gain the same number of points for any cup, the cup will be presented to the exhibitor with the most entries in the section.
7. Any person wishing to lodge an objection can do so with a deposit of £5 to the steward of the class within 15 minutes of the judging of the class disputed.
8. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident or loss incurred.
9. Only classes as stated on the schedule will be accepted for judging.
10. The Judges' decision is final.
11. The Committee reminds all competitors and exhibitors that the Show's Public Liability Insurance does not cover them and they are advised to arrange their own cover.
12. All food vendors, stallholders, attractions, entertainers etc. **MUST** have their own Public Liability and Employer's Liability Insurance covering their potential liability arising from participation at the Show. Details of the cover held and its validity for the duration of the Show must be confirmed with the Secretary prior to participation. Regrettably failure to provide this information will prevent participation at the Show.
13. No bicycles to be ridden in the stock field.

General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act 2018

Erwood and District Show is an annual village agricultural show administered on a not for profit basis by the Show Committee.
